MEMBERSHIP VOTE

A few years back we decided to move to a 2 day Tour Championship, elevating our end of season coveted event. Hawkstone Park has provided the venue for the last few years and is a favourite of many members, providing a good test of golf in idyllic surroundings.

However, costs have risen and with only 11 able to attend this year, we are proposing the following:

Option 1

• Continue with the two day overnight event at a maximum cost of £190.

Option 2

- Move to a 1 day event in September.
- The Victory Cup in August classified as a Tour Championship qualifying event (Day 1). In essence, replicating the PGA Tour Fed Ex Cup!

- Organise a curry night the eve before the September event
